

#### **Quick Play Option:**

Using all 48 cards will likely be challenging. While some players are up for the challenge, if you prefer a quick play option, separate the cards by background color before shuffling. Select 1 or 2 colors to use, and then shuffle.

Background Color / Number of cards











#### Setup:

- Shuffle the deck
- Place all cards face down and organized into a 8 x 6 rectangle (or smaller for the quick play option)
- Designate a place for the discard pile

# **Gameplay Instructions**

#### **Object of the Game:**

To earn the most points while by finding matching cards and using emotions vocabulary words in a sentence. Not all cards are worth the same amount of points, so read the directions carefully.



- 1) **Find a pair of cards** with matching faces
- 2) Earn points by using the emotion word on one of the cards in a sentence.
- 3) Place the other card in the discard pile








































#### **Playing the Game:**

- Take turns starting with the youngest player and continuing clockwise.
- Each player will flip two cards on his/her turn.





If the faces on the cards do not match, the cards are returned to their face down position, and the next player takes his/her turn.






• If the faces on the cards do match, the player will take both cards.


• The player must decide which emotion word he/she wants to use in a sentence, and then place the other card in the discard pile.






### **DEVASTATED**





If the player successfully uses the word in a sentence, he/she keeps the card and takes another turn.



#### **Winning the Game**

After all matches are found, players will tally their point totals using the cards they kept (not any cards in the discard pile). The player with the most points wins.

## Hint:

All matching pairs are all synonyms (they mean the same thing). So to earn more points, use the 1 point cards to learn the definition of the word, and use the 2 point cards to create your sentences.
